<p>Narrative description: This is a Level 1 paddle exploring some of the lakes/ivers on Sauvie Island. We will put in on Little McNary Lake and paddle to Sturgeon Lake and connect with the Gilbert River to paddle back to the Gilbert river boat ramp, only a few feet from where we put in. There is a short portage necessary to get onto Sturgeon Lake. A Sauvie Island day or year permit is required and can be purchased at the Cracker Barrel Store on the Island. We will meet on Sauvie Island at the store at 9:00am and drive to the put in. No shuttle is required as we will paddle in a loop and return to the Gilbert River and take out near where we started.</p>
