<p>Narrative description: This is day one of two days at Deception Pass, Sunday 7-12 and Monday 7-13. Sign up for one or both days. For this trip on Sunday, the plan is to ride the flood into Canoe Pass in the afternoon and spend some time getting acquainted with the rapidly changing dynamics of the area. This is a good trip to test your pool roll in conditions, and it's a good trip to use the low brace turns and rescues that you have practiced. It's a mellow trip for the area, and is an excellent opportunity to experience the pass for people who have not been to Deception Pass before. Some informal instruction will be available but it is a trip not a class. Its also a good warm-up trip for Monday morning's ebb, and there is camping available at Bowman Bay or rooms in nearby Anacortes, WA. Helmets are required due to the proximity of the rocks and likelihood of capsizes.</p>
