<b>Title:</b> L&C Park to Chinook Landing		<b>Type of Activity:</b> Trip		<b>Date(s):</b> Sat. 09/19/09	
<p><b>Narrative description:</b> After launching from the L&amp;C boat ramp, we'll head upstream to the bridge to get a feel for the current and talk about how to read the water and how to avoid the shallows. Our trip down the Sandy River will be at a very leisurely pace following the slow current. Just as we approach the mouth of the Sandy, the speed of the current picks up to about 3 kts for the last 1/8 mile. After entering the Columbia, we'll head slightly upstream to make our crossing. We continue upsteam around the eastern tip of Lady Island and into Camas Slough. We'll make our lunch stop on a sandy beach near the western end of the island. After lunch we'll paddle upriver along the southern shore of Lady Island before making the crossing back to the Oregon side and our take-out on the beach at Chinook Landing. Paddle distance 7-8 miles. (approx. 1 mile will be upstream against a current of approx. 1 kt). Both Columbia crossing are approx. 0.7 miles. We'll cancel the trip or eliminate the crossings if wind exceeds Level 2. A shuttle is required.</p>
