<p>Narrative description: One of my favorite places close to Portland to explore small islands. With luck there will still be fall colors and bird life to add to the beauty. We will start at Bernart Landing in West Linn and paddle approximately 2.5 miles up the Willamette to the Rock Islands where we will explore and take pictures until lunch. After lunch, if there is time and interest we will continue another 1.5-2 miles to Willow Island, circumnavigate it before starting down river to return to Bernart Landing. The trip will be anywhere from 5 to 9 miles, depending upon the sentiment of the group. Expect to be on the river (including lunch) about 5 hours. We will go rain or shine, only strong winds will cancel the trip. Dress to stay warm out or in the water. Bring a hat, preferably one designed for water in the unlikely event of a capsized. Bring lunch, including a warm drink or soup and a spirit to explore!</p>
